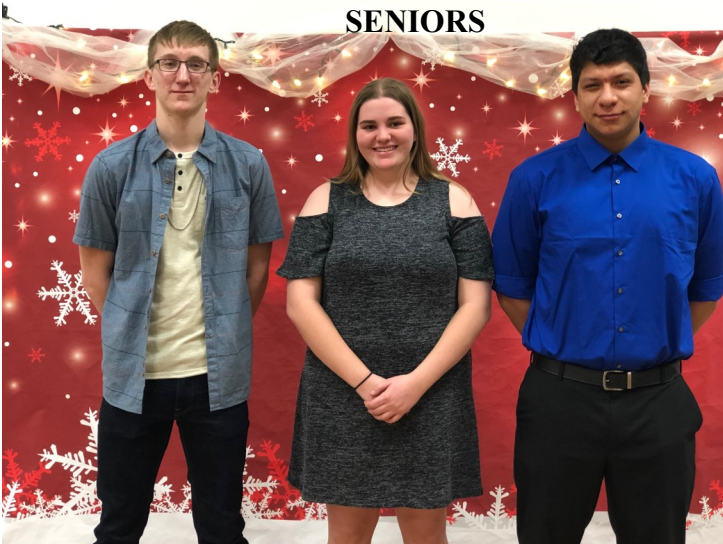

February was Children's Dental Health Month. Kelsey Irish from Carson Family Dentistry in Springfield SD visited our class to teach us about the importance of brushing our teeth for good dental health. It is important to brush our teeth at least twice a day, baby teeth are very important! If baby teeth are not taken care of it can lead to many health issues and damage our adult teeth.
