Each subject has us moving along. In reading, we are practicing main idea and supporting details, relevant and irrelevant information, contradictions, decoding words, and comprehending a story each day. In spelling, there are four rules we practice daily along with breaking words apart and finding parts that can stand alone. In science, we are studying how to prove that Earth revolves around the sun, and not the other way around. We just finished discussing why the Europeans wanted to keep moving over to North America, and what it was like when they arrived here during our social studies time. In Adventures in Language, we keep practicing our parts of speech and wrote a personal funny story. In math, concepts that we have been practicing are dividing, problem solving, factors of a number, fractions of a number, relationships of fractions, percent, and decimals, and some geometry like angles, lines, and types of polygons.

The students have been working very hard and pushing themselves every day. They finished taking their MAPS testing along with all the work they have been doing. It has been a very busy fall.
