Students who have lockers in

PE SHOES – shoes that are used for PE do not have to be new or expensive. They only need to be well fitting, clean, and have non-marking soles. Shoes that are worn outside cannot be worn on the gym floor as it causes damage.

WINTER – as cold weather arrives, elementary students need to have suitable coats, mittens, and hats. Boots and snow pants are required when it is wet. If it has rained or snowed, students without boots or a second set of dry shoes must stay on the sidewalk during recess.
