The Krebs College Scholarship Fund Trust was created by the Will of Orpha

Mae Krebs, which provided:

The trustee shall invest the principal and use so much of the net income as necessary or desirable to provide scholarships and grants to Verdigre and Niobrara area students attending an accredited college in Nebraska, full or part time. The trustee, when choosing recipients, should first consider those students whose scholastic achievements are not as great as their fellow students, but who are ambitious; sincerely wish to attend a college in Nebraska and complete their studies; who do not have the means to do so without scholarships or grants; and have an intention to return to the area after completing their education. The trustee may consider other relevant considerations. The trustee's decisions shall be final and not subject to review by the courts or otherwise.

The Farmers & Merchants State Bank is the trustee. In order to enable it to consider your application for a scholarship or grant, please answer the following questions on a separate sheet of paper (typed):

1. What was your overall grade average in high school and your class rank?
2. If applicable, what is your grade average in college?
3. Why are you or do you want to attend college?
4. What is your major and why did you select that field?
5. What do you intend to do upon your graduation?
6. What other sources of money for college do you have?

Please attach any other comments or information you believe would be helpful to the trustee in making its decision. You may reapply each year you attend college.
