

To complete the preschool application, you will need to bring in the following documents to your appointment: child's birth certificate, up-to-date immunizations record, current health insurance card, birthdates of all family members, proof of income for the last 12 month, 2019 tax return or all W2s for 2019, documentation of public assistance (SSI, TANF) if applicable and any other form of income such as child support.
