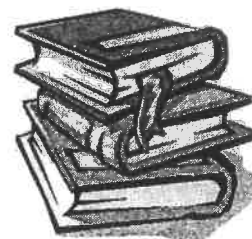

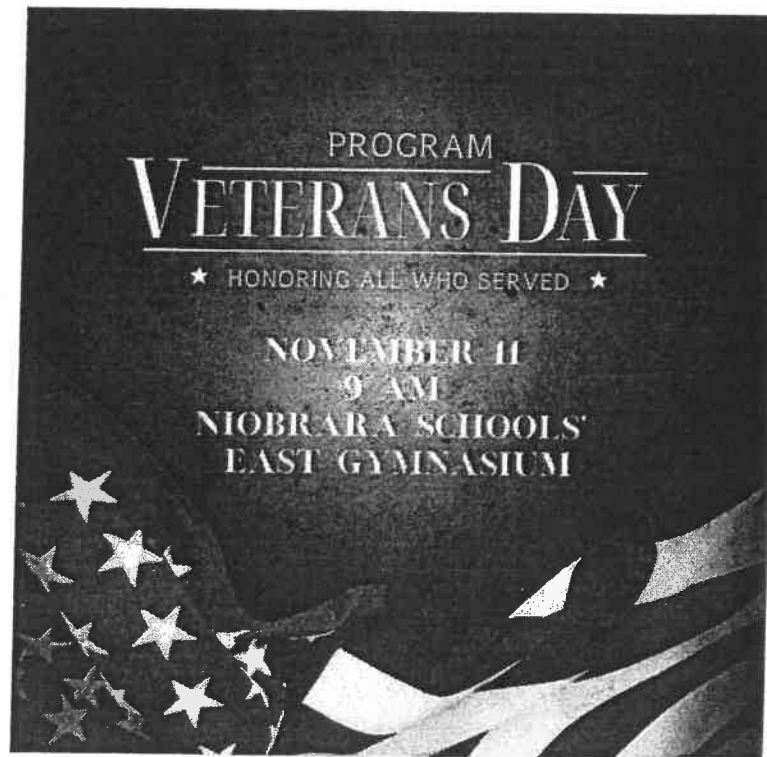


### Math News

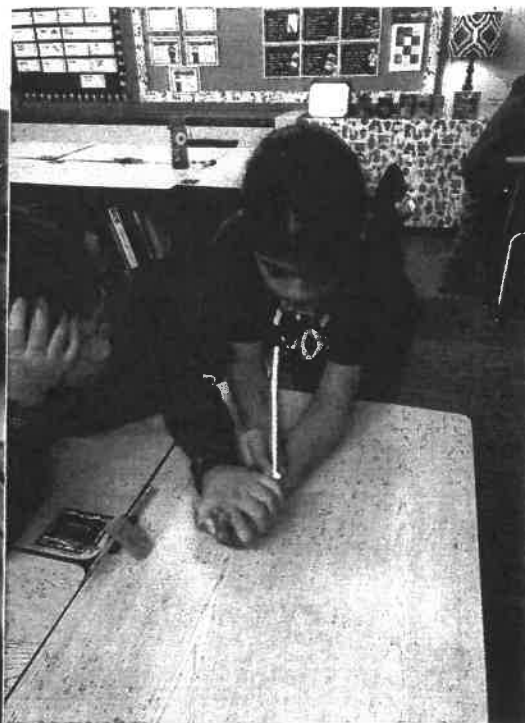
### Reading and Writing

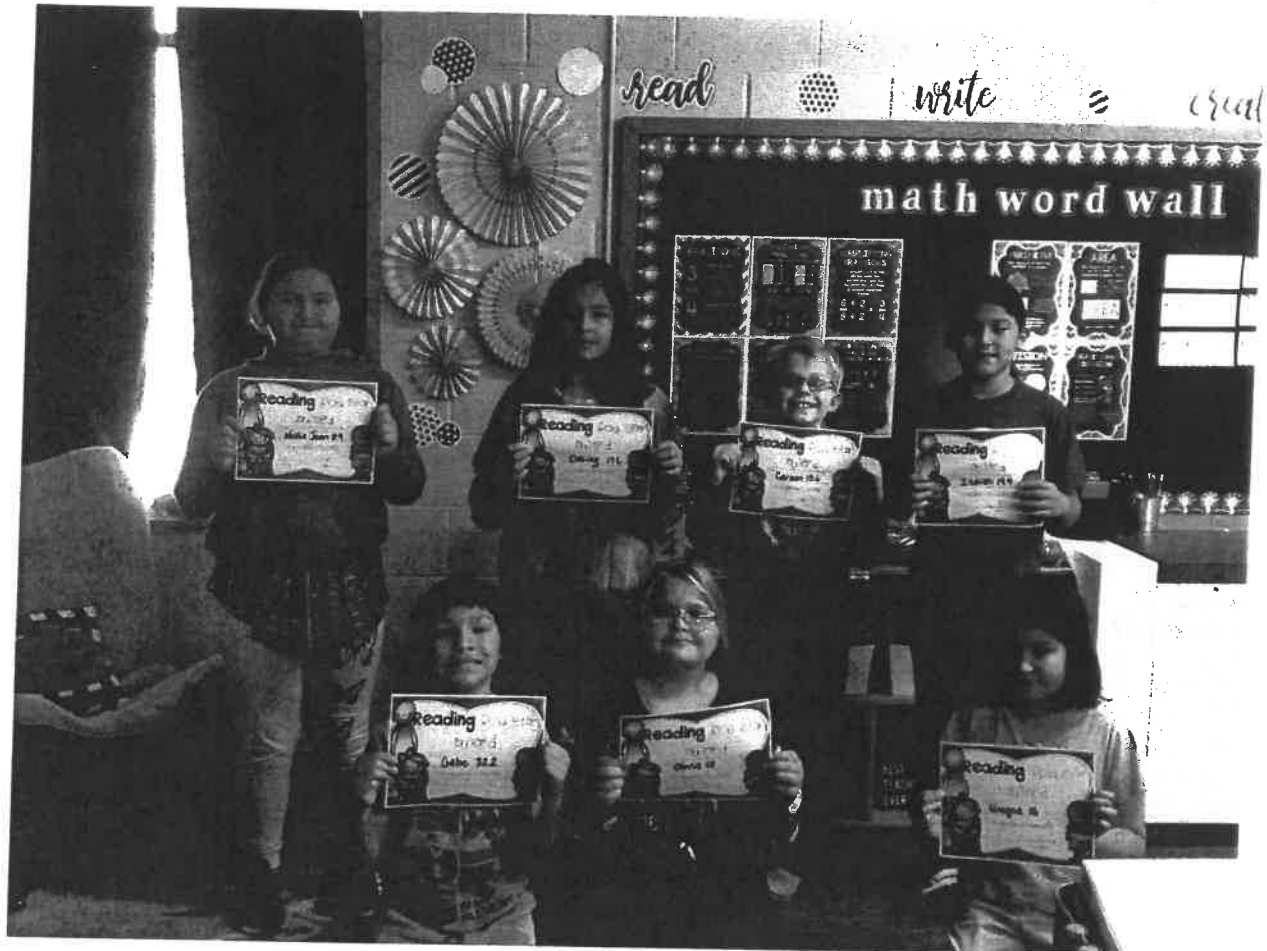

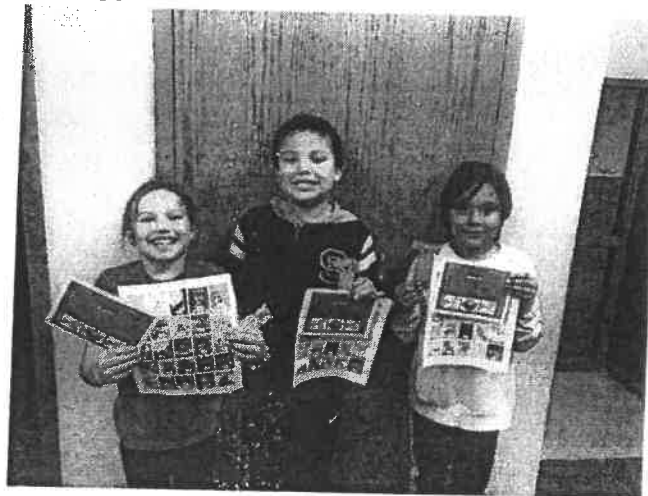
**November is also Native American Heritage Month.** We will be celebrating Native American authors that we currently have in the library. Books and information will be showcased all throughout the library!

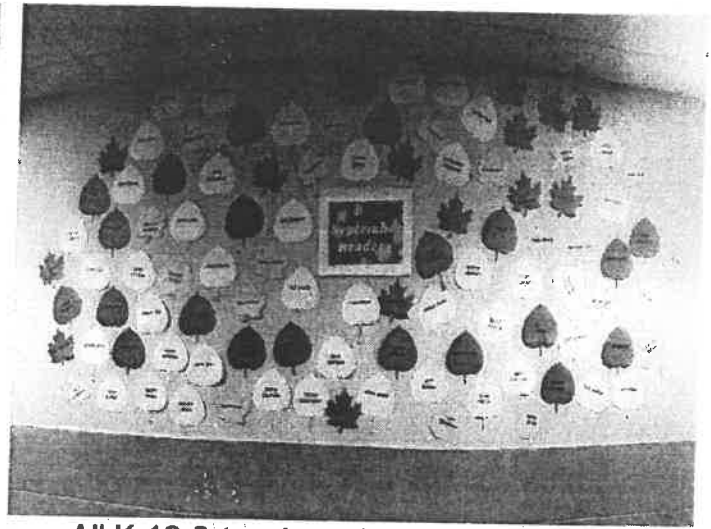

We will be taking 4 students to the NVC Vocal Clinic. Pearl Klug, Austinia Latorra, Billie Pritchett, and Tiffany Thieman. I hope everyone will come to watch our final concert at 5:30. It's close to home this year, at the Verdigre School Gym.

**Beginning Band:** Wow! The 5<sup>th</sup> grade students have learned 5 notes, whole notes & rests, half notes and rests, and quarter notes and rests. We are still working on keeping a steady beat by tapping our feet while playing our instruments. It's not easy, but it is getting easier. The drummers have learned half notes & rests, quarter notes & rests, single paradiddles, the multiple bounce stroke, and learning to put together the bass drum music with the snare music to play independent parts.

The Sixth-grade students aren't quite as far as fifth grade because we've missed some Monday's due to not being in session, but they are learning and coming along. They have the first 3 notes and whole & half notes. With both groups we have four flutes, three clarinets, four trumpets, 1 trombone, and 4 drummers.
